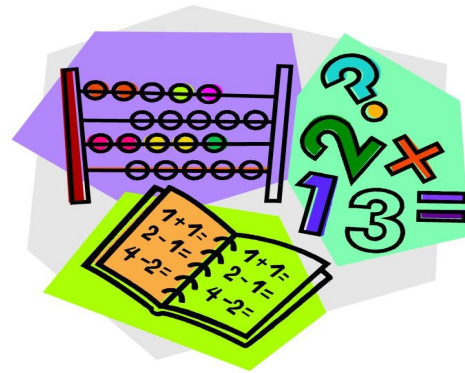


6TH GRADE MATHEMATICS

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING:

During the first quarter, our class will cover a Math Boot Camp and one unit of study: The Number System. More specifically, we will be computing with multi-digit numbers and multiplying and dividing fractions. Throughout the rest of the year, we will cover: Ratios and Proportional Relationships, Expressions and Equations, Geometry, and Statistics and Probability. All of these units of study have been created and are based off of the Common Core State standards.

Students will be given each chapter of their “write-in” notes separately to keep in their Math binders.

CONSEQUENCES:

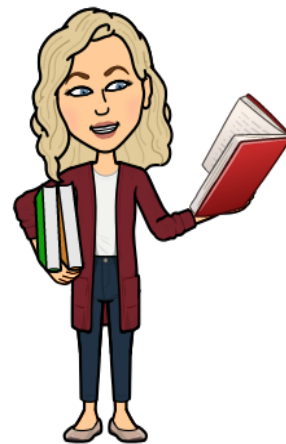
If a student chooses to break a classroom expectation, the following may occur:

GOOGLE CLASSROOM:

Google Classroom will be our classroom platform for information and announcements, instructional videos, assignments, and other resources.

For remote learning days students should log in to Google Classroom and complete the assignments task(s).



ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING:

In Math class, grades are based on a weighted system. Participation, classwork, and homework assignments are worth 50% of the grade. The other 50% comes from quizzes, projects, tests, and other assessments. Individual homework assignments are worth 5 points.

Homework grading scale:

5 points = 100%

4.5 points = 90%

4 points = 80%

3.5 points = 70%

3 points = 60%

2.5 points = 50%

2 points = 40%

1.5 points = 30%

1 point = 20%

0.5 point = 10%

Although paper copies of homework assignments will be provided during hybrid learning, students will be submitting their homework on Google Classroom (through a Google Form).

Assignments should be completed and turned in by the start of school the following day (7:30 AM), unless otherwise noted. For example, assignments given on Monday (in person or remote) are due Tuesday morning by 7:30 AM. Partial credit may be given for late assignments.

Assignments will be posted in the classroom (for in-person learning) and on Google Classroom (for remote learning).
